Declaration of the Major

To declare a major in Finance, a student must meet the following requirements:

- Completion of 28 hours at DePaul University
- Completion of the Introductory Commerce courses with
 - A minimum grade of C- in each course
 - A minimum grade point average of 2.0 for the combined courses
- A minimum cumulative DePaul grade point average of 2.7
- A minimum Finance grade point average of 2.7
- No grade of IN, R, M or lower than C- in any FIN course or course used toward the FIN major
- Completion of FIN 310 with a minimum grade of B-

Declaration of **Finance Honors** requires acceptance into the Finance Honors Program, junior standing with an overall GPA of 3.3 or better, a B+ or better in FIN 310, and declaration of Finance as a major.

Electives must be chosen from FIN 323 Commercial Banking, FIN 335 Portfolio Management, FIN 337 Options, FIN 339 Financial Futures, FIN 340 International Finance, FIN 350 Real Estate Analysis, FIN 352 Real Estate Finance, FIN 353 Real Estate Investment, FIN 354 Real Estate Valuation, FIN 355 Real Estate Valuations II, FIN 362 Risk Management, FIN 393 Finance Internship, FIN 395 Investment Seminar, FIN 397 Finance Seminar, FIN 398 Special Topics (multiple topics may be used), and FIN 399 Independent Study.

The Department of Finance enforces all **course prerequisites**; exceptions will not be made.

FIN 312 Corporate Financial Management is a capstone course—taking this course during the last quarter of studies is recommended.

Students are encouraged to seek an **internship** with a Chicago-area business during the summer preceding either their Junior or Senior year.

Degree Requirements

All FIN courses and any courses used toward the FIN major must be completed with a minimum grade of C-.

All FIN courses and any courses used toward the FIN major must equal a minimum grade point average of 2.0 when combined.
